## **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:**

- 1. You must be a candidate for participation:
  - Current full-time matriculated University Housing Residents.
  - Current participants in SU's Abroad program/COOP/Internship during Spring 2018 who resided in University housing in the semester immediately preceding their semester away, who notified the housing office of their desire to participate.
  - Fall 2018 new SU transfer student who submitted an e-mail to housing with your name and your SU I.D. number, confirming they wish to reside with you in a 6-person suite and you complete and attach a new student pull-in form with this request.
- 2. You and your intended roommate(s) each have the \$450 advance housing payment posted, waived or credit applied towards the housing advance:
- 3. You and your intended roommate(s) completed the Room Selection Application by March 20.
- 4. For learning communities requiring pre-approval, <u>all</u> listed students on this form must be approved for the learning community.

- Only one learning community approval will be issued per student so no more than one Learning Community may be listed. All students in your group must be approved for the same learning community to be assigned to the learning community.

- Six-person suite requests must be able to fill the room to capacity (i.e. 6 people for a 6-person suite) AND ARE <u>NOT</u> AVAILABLE TO STUDENTS ASSIGNED TO THE <u>ORANGE TRACK</u>

Random assignments are made to 6-person suites and to Learning Community room type requests
